The Silver Fox Tips from experience...

For the gardener in your family: Worn-out sandpaper is great to deter those yucky garden slugs, or under your plant pots to keep them out! Cut a circle from the used sandpaper, with a slit and open circle in the center, and put it around the base of your outdoor plants; Or cut a piece 2 inches larger than the pot base, and put it underneath to pot. Just make sure the rough side is up — Slugs don't like crawling over it!

It is important to know when to stop arguing with people, and to simply let them be wrong.

Increase CA glue shelf life by storing only UNOPENED bottles in your refrigerator. Once they've opened, store them in an airtight lidded container with desiccant packs inside.

Huh, I thought growing old would take longer. So now I'm a multitasker: I can listen, ignore, and forget all at the same time!






Meeting Location
