

Tools from Allen Wrenches

At the last meeting, for those that attended, Lou Currier did a demonstration on making a hollowing tool from an Allen Wrench. I'm sure most of you have more spare Allen wrenches laying around than you know what to do with. Below is a picture of the tool Lou finished. When done you can turn a nice custom handle to fit plus a ferral to keep everything tight so no splitting occurs.

Membership


