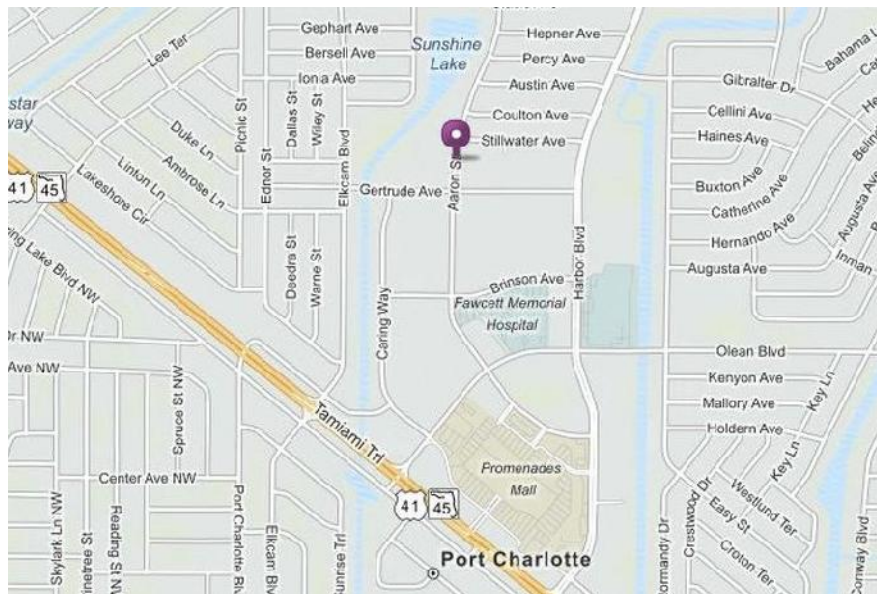
Meeting Location
