




LEFT HAND CURVED, SIDE CUT SCRAPER


Rectangular section

Left skew square side cut scraper




Right hand skew scraper




Opposite handed scrapers also useful

1/4"	9"


TOOLS OF THE TRADE - GOUGES

SHALLOW FLUTED GOUGE

Detail Grind

Definition:-

A gouge where the flute is less than a semi-circle.




DEEP FLUTED GOUGE

(The "O'Donnell Grind")


Definition:-

A gouge where the flute extends beyond a semi-circle.

Rectangular section




Round all corners for

angle 60 deg




Bevel angles 15 deg





